



#### **LEATHER**

- 1. BACK (X2)
- 2. WRAP POCKET

#### STITCHING AND BURNISHING SUPPLIES

- +NEEDLES
- +THREAD: (X2) 20"
- +CANVAS
  - +SANDPAPER
  - +BEESWAX

\*You should know\*




PAPER BINDER CLIPS ARE PERFECT FOR HOLDING LAYERS OF LEATHER TOGETHER WHILE YOU STITCH. THEY SERVE THE PURPOSE OF SEWING PINS. **STEP 1:** (Optional) Burnish everywhere marked by the grey lines below:

ALL STITCHING START POINTS ARE MARKED WITH A STAR.




FLESH VS. GRAIN COLORATION






**STEP 2:** Line up the two backs (1) flesh sides together. Fold the wrap pocket (2) in half and sandwich the backs (1) between it. Binder clips are helpful at this point.



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

**STEP 3:** Prepare your needles. Starting on the left side of the wallet, begin with your needle in the bottom stitching hole. Begin to saddle stitch all the way up the left side. When you reach the top, back stitch twice. Pull both needles through to one side, snip and carefully burn threads.




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**STEP 4:** Repeat step 3 on the right side of the wallet. Starting with your needle in the very bottom hole of the right side seam, begin to saddle stitch up the left side of the wallet. When you reach the top hole, back stitch. Pull both needles through to the same side as in step 3. Snip and carefully burn threads.




**STEP 5:** (Optional) Sand then burnish the outer edges of wallet marked by grey lines below.
