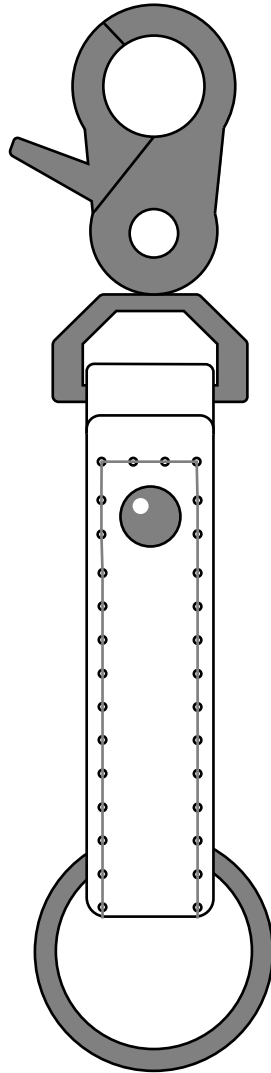

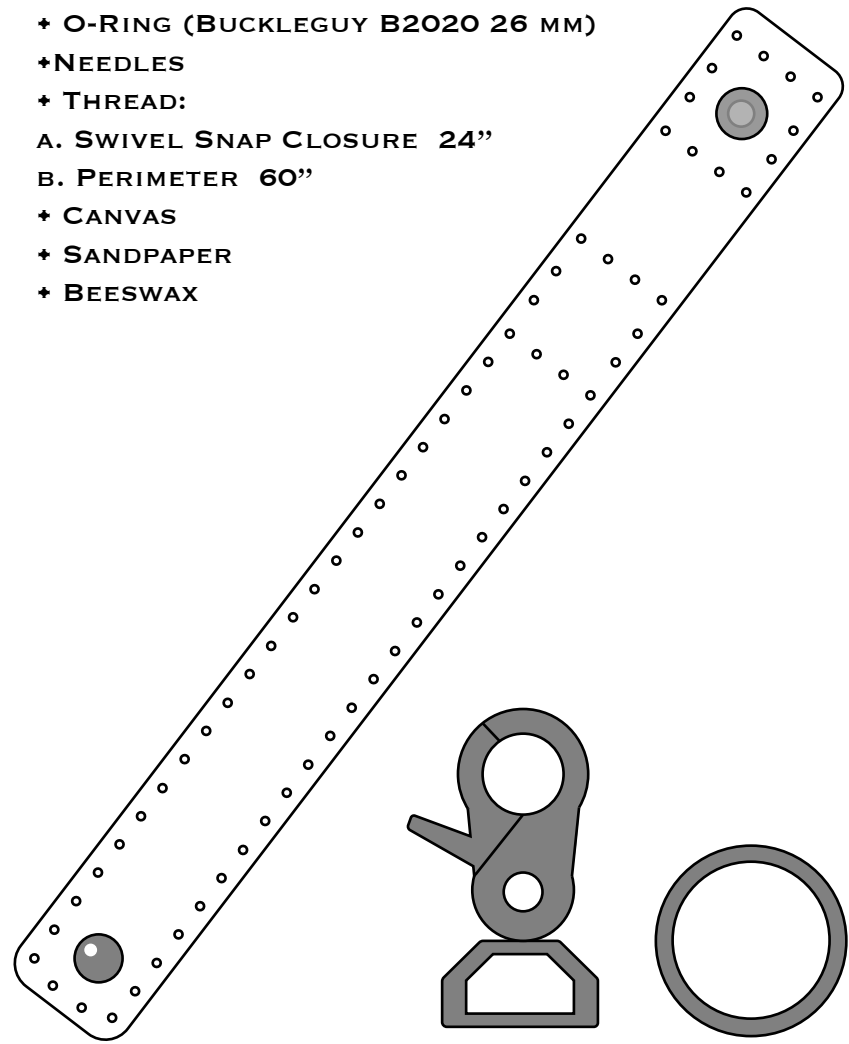

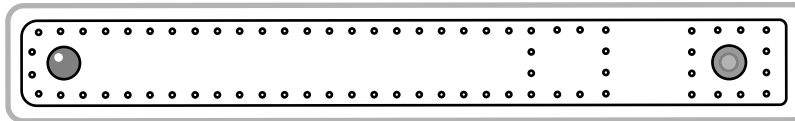
- + LEATHER STRAP
- + SWIVEL SNAP (BUCKLEGUY 3002A 1")
- + O-RING (BUCKLEGUY B2020 26 MM)
- + NEEDLES
- + THREAD:
 - A. SWIVEL SNAP CLOSURE 24"
 - B. PERIMETER 60"
- + CANVAS
- + SANDPAPER
- + BEESWAX



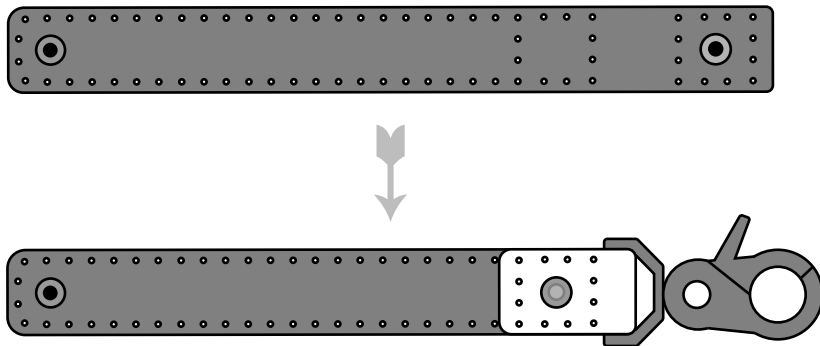
FLESH VS. GRAIN COLORATION



STEP 1: (Optional) Burnish the outer edge of the leather strap.



STEP 2: Slide the swivel snap onto the flat edge of the leather strap. Fold the leather under to sandwich the swivel snap, lining up the square pattern seams.

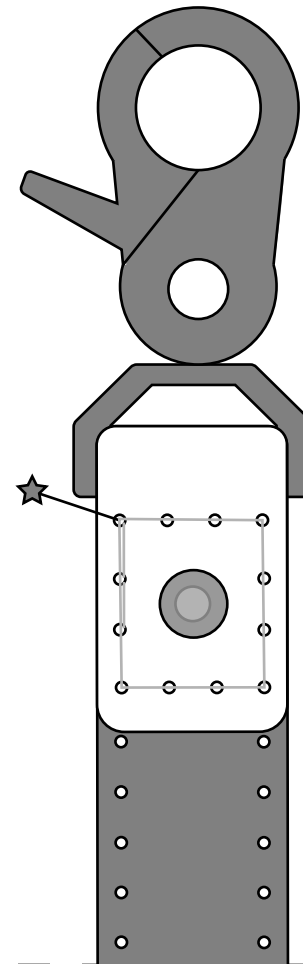

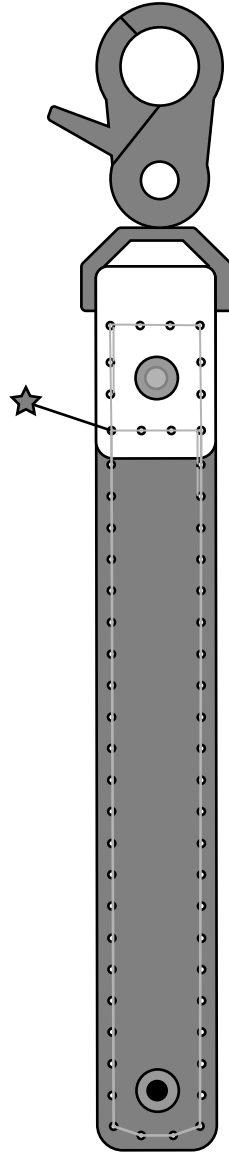

STEP 3: Prepare your needles. Begin with your needle in the top left corner of the square pattern, and saddle stitch down the left seam, over to the right for the bottom seam, up the right side seam and back to the left to reach the stitch where you started. Continue to saddle stitch two more stitches beyond your initial stitch. This will act as your back stitch. Pull both threads through to the flesh side of the leather strap. Snip and carefully burn threads.



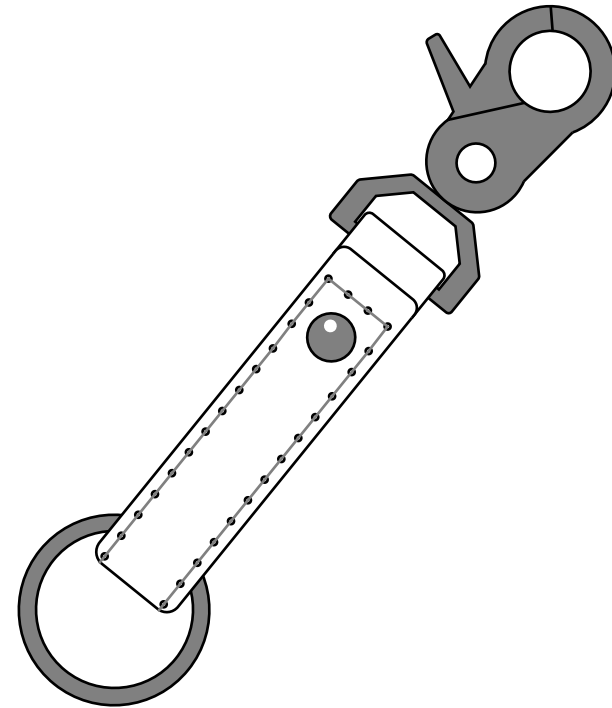
STEP 4: Prepare your needles. Starting in the bottom left corner of the square pattern stitched in step 2, begin to saddle stitch down the perimeter of the strap. Continue all the way around the perimeter until you reach the bottom right corner of the square pattern from step 2. Back stitch and pull both needles through to the flesh side. Snip and carefully burn threads.

STEP 5: Slide on the O-ring and snap the snap closed!



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
